Mix, Swish, and Brew: Create chemical concoctions that pop and fizz, mysterious solutions with curious properties, and slimy substances as you explore chemistry via diverse hands-on experiments.

STEM with SteAm:: Explore the principles of physics and engineering while constructing unusual contraptions.
(\$10/day lab fee)

Stories and Art: The Caldecott Winners: Why is a book a Caldecott winner? How does art express a story? How does a story inspire art? Explore artistic styles found in the superbly illustrated winners of the Caldecott Medal. Create stories and illustrations of your own.

Program Details

The 2017 winter Worlds of Wisdom and Wonder programs of The Center for Gifted are designed for bright, motivated learners who welcome dynamic opportunities to explore diverse subjects in a challenging, creative environment. The development of problem-solving skills, creativity, and critical thinking is inherent in the framework for all courses and workshops. Projects and activities evoke active, hands-on participation.

In Evanston we offer a four-day program which meets for 2½ hours on Saturday afternoons. The program format for each student is determined by grade level and/or course selection.

Applicants need not have qualified for advanced programming at their schools; test scores are not the only criteria for our programs. Although our students generally rank at or above the 95th percentiles in some areas, we recognize and discern the great variety of talents and abilities that children express. If uncertain about their child's eligibility or in cases of exceptionality, parents are welcome and encouraged to request a conversation or meeting with the CFG Director, Joan Franklin Smutny.

Tuition for the Evanston Worlds of Wisdom and Wonder program (4 sessions) is \$180; for the STEM with SteAm workshop, tuition is \$45 per day.
