Online application is available at www.centerforgifted.org, where you also will find links to all program flyers and descriptions. There are no application deadlines. Enrollment remains open for each program until it begins or until the program is full; some programs have limited enrollment.

Full tuition and lab fees (if any) must accompany application. Tuition and fees are fully refundable for withdrawals requested before the program begins. Financial assistance is not available for our winter and spring programs.

Our winter and spring programs do not require teacher recommendations. Age-appropriate students are accepted upon application as space allows. Students who enjoy and do well at our one-day programs may then enroll in future CFG programs as “returning” students, without teacher recommendation.

Students who benefit from our programs are generally bright, motivated, and eager to be challenged and inspired. They welcome the opportunities we offer—to explore diverse subjects in a challenging, creative environment; exciting projects and activities that evoke active, hands-on participation.
